Hidden Valley Conservation Ads

Members may have noticed ads for the Hidden Valley Conservation Club (HVCC) in recent editions of the newsletter. Now close to forty years old, the HVCC exists to provide its members with quality bird hunting experiences safely and at reasonable cost on private farm land on Vancouver Island.

Several of the HVCC's Directors are also members of the Victoria Fish and Game Club and the acquisition this year of two waterfowl hunting farms south of Nanaimo was aimed at making the HVCC more attractive to Victoria members. Duck hunting on these farms takes place on Wednesdays and Saturdays with goose hunting by email announcement. The HVCC also hunts ducks on a Comox farm on Tuesdays and Saturdays.

In addition, released pheasants and chukar partridges are hunted on the HVCC's farms in Parksville and Black Creek, with English Style Pheasant Shoots offered several times a year on the Parksville farm.
